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Line up begins at 5:00pm at the former Robert Frost School, behind Dairy Queen. Judging will begin promptly at 5:45. The Parade will leave the school at 6:30, ending at the Festival Grounds. Floats and displays in the children’s parade cannot be larger than the back of a standard-size pick-up truck; approximately 5 by 8 feet. To be eligible for the non-profit category, groups must be comprised of or open to children under 18. Youth groups, school groups, sports teams, summer camps, and support groups are welcome to participate. Children must be accompanied by an adequate number of adults at all times. Business and political groups are encouraged to participate in the Grand Parade on Sunday, June 25th. Child-based businesses are allowed in the Children’s parade at the discretion of the Parade Director and the Children’s Parade Coordinator.
