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RULES AND REGULATIONS

BOURBONNAIS FRIENDSHIP FESTIVAL, INC.

The Bourbonnais Friendship Festival, Inc. reserves the right to reject any application.

The Concession Committee and Bourbonnais Friendship Festival, Inc. Committee will not be held responsible for loss of any goods or property or be responsible for any injuries to any concessionaires.

All vendors and concessionaires must remove from display and/or sale any items or articles deemed objectionable by the Festival Committee.

All vendors and/or concessionaires will be contacted by letter, call or email of official notice of acceptance or denial of concession space from the Concession Committee.

All applications for concession space must be submitted no later than **May 15, 2020 WITH FULL PAYMENT DUE**. No refunds on deposits or payments in full. Prior year concessionaires will have space held until April 10, 2020. After April 10th, it will be first-come, first-served.

All concessionaires must have a 10# fire extinguisher on site in order to sell hot food.

All tents and or canvas awnings will be marked as flame-retardant or fire resistant.

Vendors are responsible for providing necessary items in their controlled area.

No electrical cords smaller than #12 gauge shall be permitted.

Vendors can only sell items listed on application.

Vendors are responsible for disposing of their own garbage. Dumpsters are provided for your use. The Bourbonnais Friendship Festival is not responsible for your garbage. Failure to comply may result in fines.

All drain hoses will be routed to the nearest storm sewer.

There will be no alcoholic beverages outside designated areas.

No vendor will be allowed to sell outside of their designated area.

All vendors must send a copy of liability insurance of \$1,000,000.00 with application.

The following items are restricted to carnival vendors unless otherwise authorized:

- Hot dog / Regular or Foot long
- Elephant Ears
- Cotton Candy
- Lemon / and/or any flavor Shake-ups
- Soft Serve Ice Cream
- Corn Dogs
- Snow Cones or Similar Items
- Popcorn / Carmel Corn
- Carmel Apples

NO CONCESSIONAIRE VEHICLES will be allowed on the grounds during the open hours of the festival. The vehicles must be moved one hour prior to the opening hour each day.

All food vendors will be required to accept \$4.00 food coupons from the Festival volunteers. Change must be given for food coupons. Coupons must be turned in at the Hotline trailer at the close of the festival Sunday evening. Reimbursement checks will be mailed to concessionaires following the close of the event.

No vehicles will be allowed on the Festival grounds one hour prior to the opening hour until one hour after closing each.

All vehicles on the grounds between these times and dates will be towed at the owner's expense.

In the event of an emergency, a Festival Committee Member will drive the vehicle on the grounds.

All vendors will be required to remain open for all hours listed above. Failure to remain open could restrict vendor from obtaining a permit in future years.

All vendors will be required to sell in their designated areas only. Failure to do so could result in immediate expulsion. It is against village ordinance to sell outside of the designated space (Ord. 91-826 Sec 42-19).
